# Spooky Recipes



### **Ghost Cookies**

Ingredients:

• 200g softened (unsalted) butter

• 200g golden caster sugar

1 large egg

• 1/2 tsp vanilla extract

• 400g plain flour

• 20g candy or sprinkles

White, black, and grey sugar paste

• 100g icing sugar

-----

1. Preheat oven to 200C and line a baking tray with parchment paper.

2. Put the butter in a bowl and beat until soft and creamy

3. beat in the sugar, egg, vanilla, and flour (one at a time) to make a dough

4. knead and wrap in cling film and put in the fridge for 30 minutes

5. Roll out the dough until approx. 5mm thick

- 6. Use a cookie cuter in the shape of a ghost (or whatever shape you want)
- 7. Cut a circle in the center of half of the cookies and bake for 10-12min until pale but cooked through

8. Once cooled, mix the icing sugar with 3tbsp of water and mix well

9. Spread icing on the edge of the cookies that still have their centers and then press a cookie with a center missing on top

10. Sprinkle the candy into the pocket you created and then cover that cookie with one that still has its center on it to create a 3-layered cookie

11. Set aside and let the icing and decorations settle

12. Once firm, use the sugar paste to decorate the biscuits

13. **Enjoy!**



Instructions: Trace the path through the maze. Help get the ghost to the haunted house for Halloween.




